PACKAGE CHECK LIST

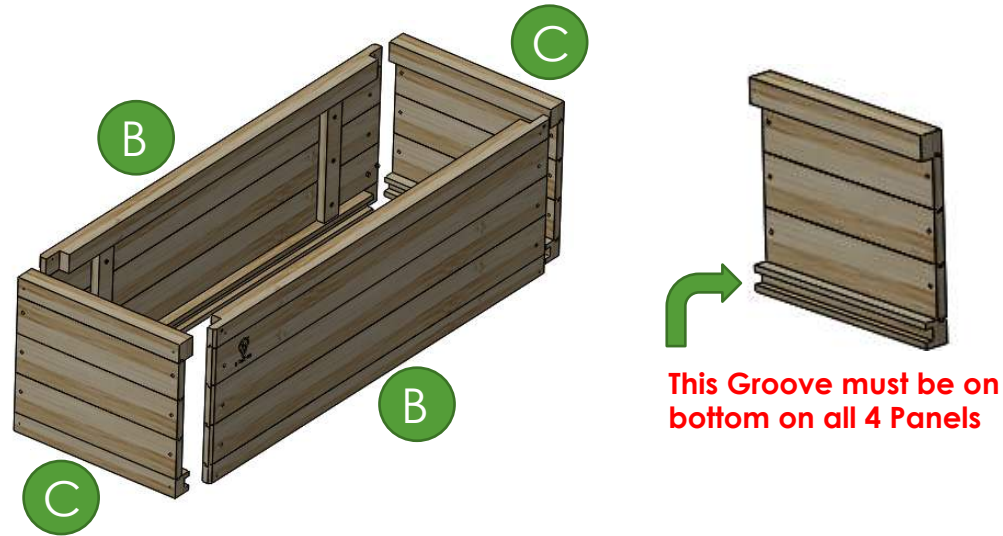
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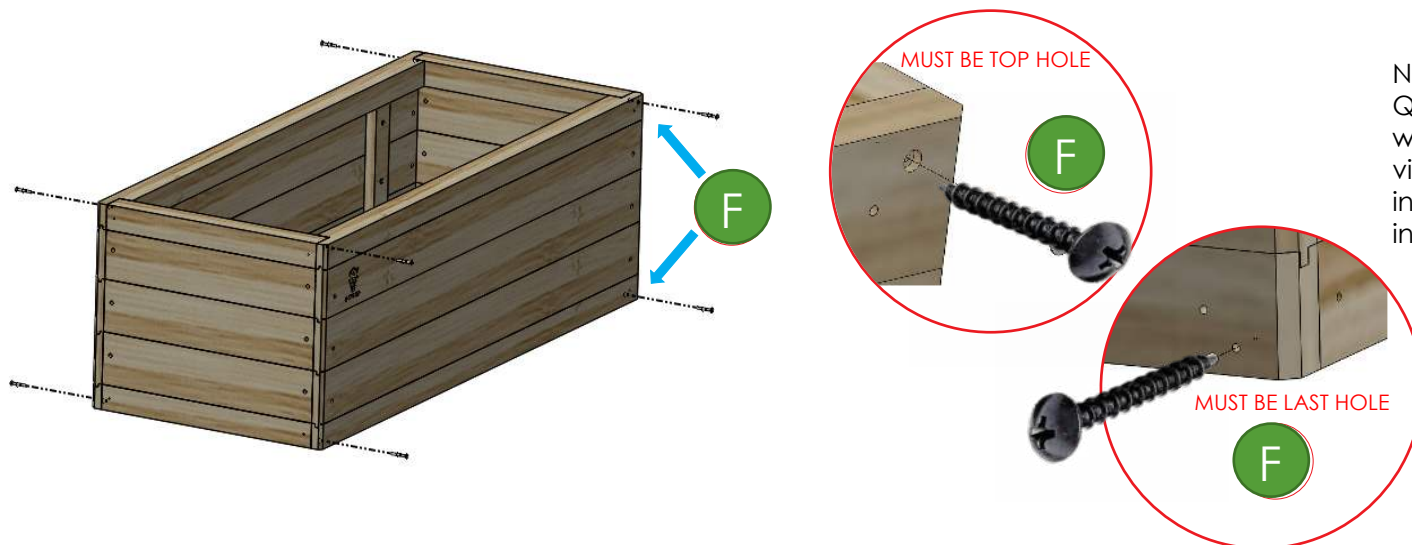
Step 1

Position Front/Rear Panel (B) and Side Panel (C) together creating a box. Ensure the groove is on the bottom on all panels. **See Diagram.**



Step 2

Tighten 2 screws (F) on each corner (one on top 1st hole and one on last bottom hole) of **Front/Rear panel**. Ensure the corners are aligned correctly. Do not over tighten screws. **See Diagram.**

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Step 3

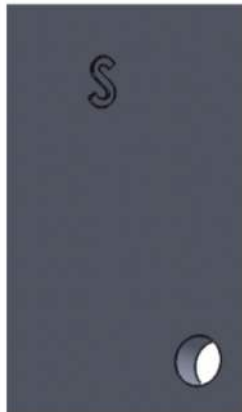
Turn planter box on side. Attach 1 GFRP Leg (A) to both corners of the planter box with 3 Bolts (H) and 3 Nuts (I), using an Allen key (J) and Spanner (K). **When attaching the GFRP leg (A) ensure the (S) sticker is on the Side Panel of the planter.** Total 6 bolts and 6 nuts per leg. Do not over tighten bolts and nuts. **See Diagram. IF EASIER YOU CAN HAND TIGHTEN BOLTS AND NUTS FOR NOW AND THEN FULLY TIGHTEN ONCE PLANTER IS UPRIGHT AFTER STEP 6.**

Step 4

Tighten Screw (G) 4 per each leg. Do not over tighten screws. Next, insert Top Leg Cap and Bottom Leg Cap on both GFRP Legs. **See Diagram.**

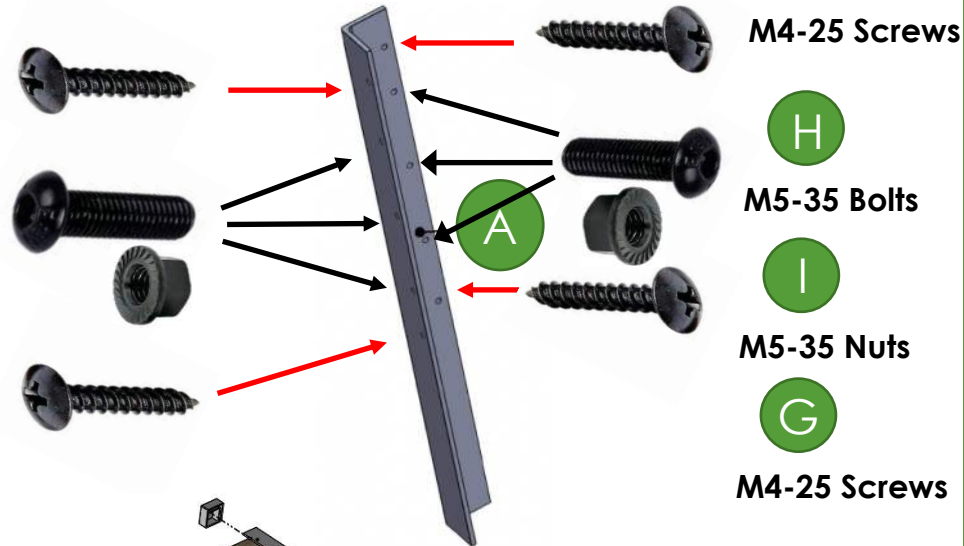
Step 5

Flip planter on other side and repeat Steps 3 and 4.

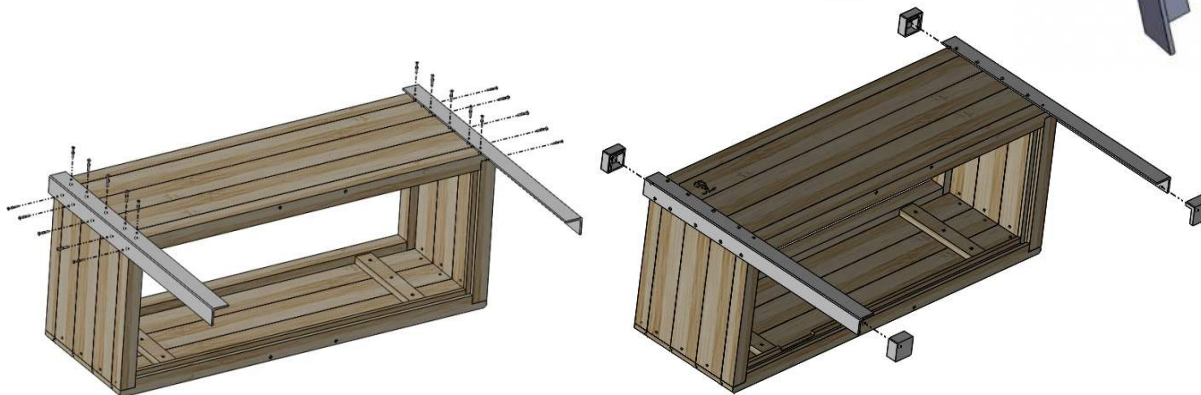


GFRP Leg should be placed with "S" mark showing on Top of the Side Panel.

*If this is not correctly placed the bolts and screws will not align.



***Note: You may need to press the GRP legs or lightly hammer the bolts into the holes. - If the leg caps are difficult to insert, gently tap them in with a hammer.**



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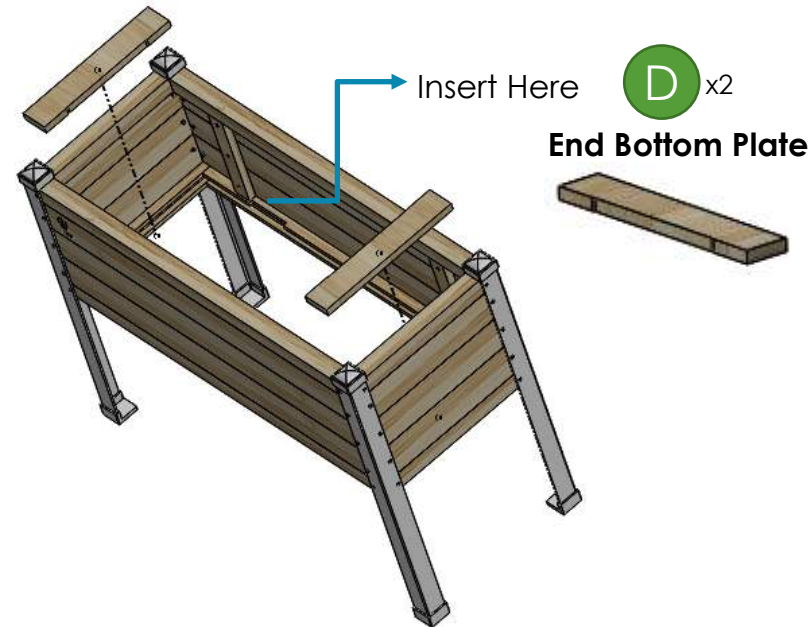
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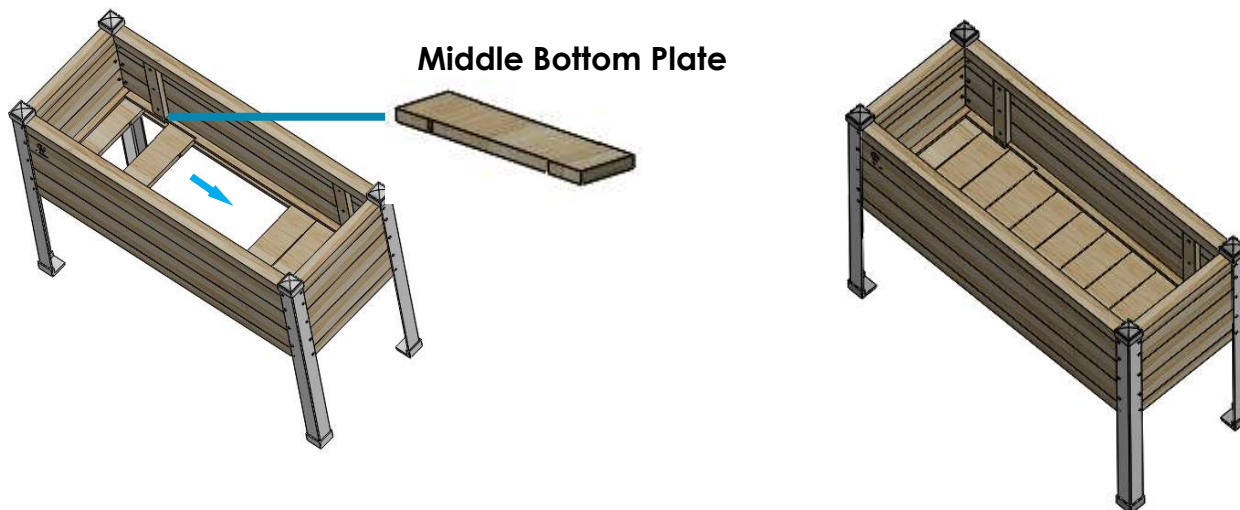
Step 6

Place planter box in upright position. Insert End Bottom Plates (D) into pre cut part of groove and slide one to the left and one to the right. Ensure the flat end go towards the ends of the box. **See Diagram.**



Step 7

Insert remaining Middle Bottom Plates into groove and slide across. **See Diagram.**



***Note:**
Once all plates are inserted and there is a bigger gap remaining, move the end bottom plates inwards. See assembly video.

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SAFETY & WARRANTY

Important Notice:

- Do not add soil to your planter until it has been positioned in its final location. Adding soil before positioning can make the planter excessively heavy and difficult to move, as it is not designed to be relocated with soil inside. If you need to move the planter later, be sure to remove the soil beforehand to prevent injury and potential damage.

Please Read Prior to Use:

- Avoid climbing into the planters at all costs and ensure that children or pets do not explore inside or underneath the planter box.
- The spanner provided should only be used for tightening the bolts on the planters. Keep it out of the reach of children.
- Do not place rocks, plastic, or any non-soil and non-plant items in the planter box. The planter box is exclusively for gardening purposes.
- Failure to comply with these safety standards will void your warranty and may result in injury.

Warranty Duration

Planters: Limited 1 year and 1 month from the date of purchase.

Warranty Coverage: This warranty strictly covers structural defects, including but not limited to:

- Structural cracks that compromise the product's integrity.
- Significant warping that affects usability.
- Manufacturing defects that impair the product's functionality.
